What is Summer Camp?

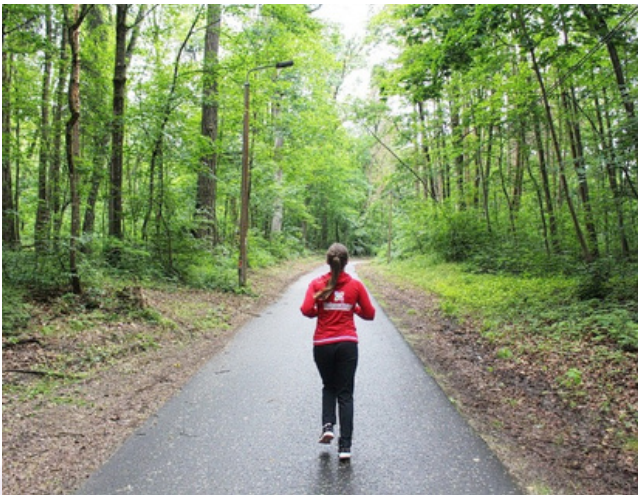
Since 1999, every year pewobe g GmbH in Frankfurt (Oder) has been hosting a Summer Camp of Partner Towns. Young People with their leaders, from Nimes (France), Witebsk (Belarus), Słubice (Poland), Gorzów Wielkopolski (Poland), Sumy/Shostka (Ukraine), Kadima-Zoran (Israel), Vratza (Bulgaria) and Heilbronn (Germany) meet in Frankfurt (Oder) at the HeleneCamp. The Sommercamp has become the most important partnership project of the city of Frankfurt (Oder). There are many activities and events during this 2 weeks. Every year participants take part in numerous workshops, organize cultural evenings and other interesting activities.



Where does it take place?

Summer Camp will take place at HeleneCamp in Frankfurt (Oder). The center is located at Lake Helene, about 20 minutes from the city of Frankfurt (Oder). There you will also find a sports field, a fireplace and a sports hall. Participants will be accommodated in rooms, of 3 to 6 people. They will be mixed nationally. Participants are not gender-mixed. The accommodation building has a shared bathroom for each gender.



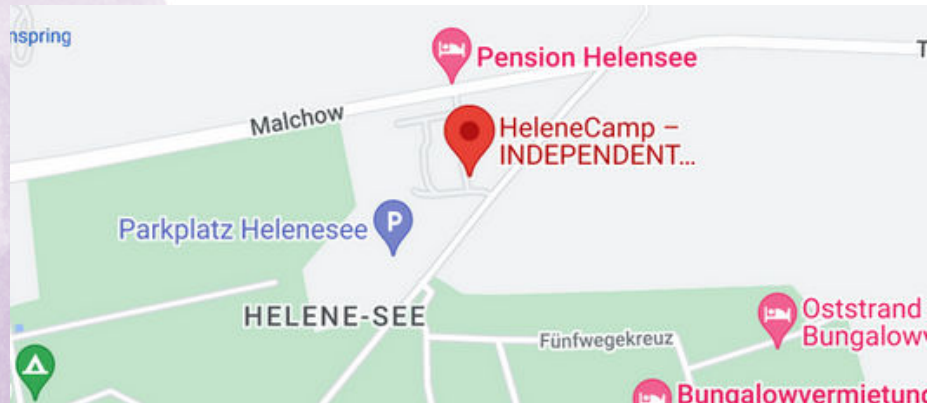

Who are the participants?

Each delegation consists of 10 members, including 8 participants and 2 leaders. Participants are aged between 13 and 18. They come from the twin cities of Frankfurt (Oder).

Who are the organisers?

Delegations will be hosted by pewobe g GmbH in Frankfurt (Oder), a non-profit organization in the youth welfare service operating in the Berlin-Brandenburg region. Since 1996, pewobe has been responsible for several kindergartens, youth clubs, assisted living for youngsters and other social facilities. pewobe also hosts and sends abroad young people with fewer opportunities. Education for tolerance is incorporated in all of its projects.

What are the meals?

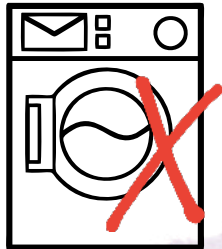
There will be three meals offered per day. At least one of them will be a warm dish. Please let us know in advance if you have any food allergies or special dietary needs (vegetarian, vegan, etc.). Keep in mind: In Germany, it is common to eat a warm meal only once per day, usually for lunch. For the other meals, we eat a lot of sandwiches. You will not be able to prepare your own meals.

What to prepare and bring?

During the camp, participants will have the opportunity to show their country and its culture. Please be prepared for this event and bring all the necessary items for this. We would be delighted to taste food from your region or country - but please note that it is not possible to heat or prepare food at our accommodation. During the camp there will also be all kinds of themed workshops, Talent Show or Fashion show - more details will be given to the leaders during the Summer Camp. There is no shop near the center, please stock up on all necessary items, cosmetics and medicines.



There is no kitchen in the accommodation.



There is no washing machine.

There are no kettles and fridges in the rooms.

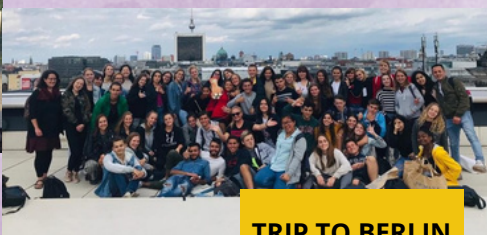

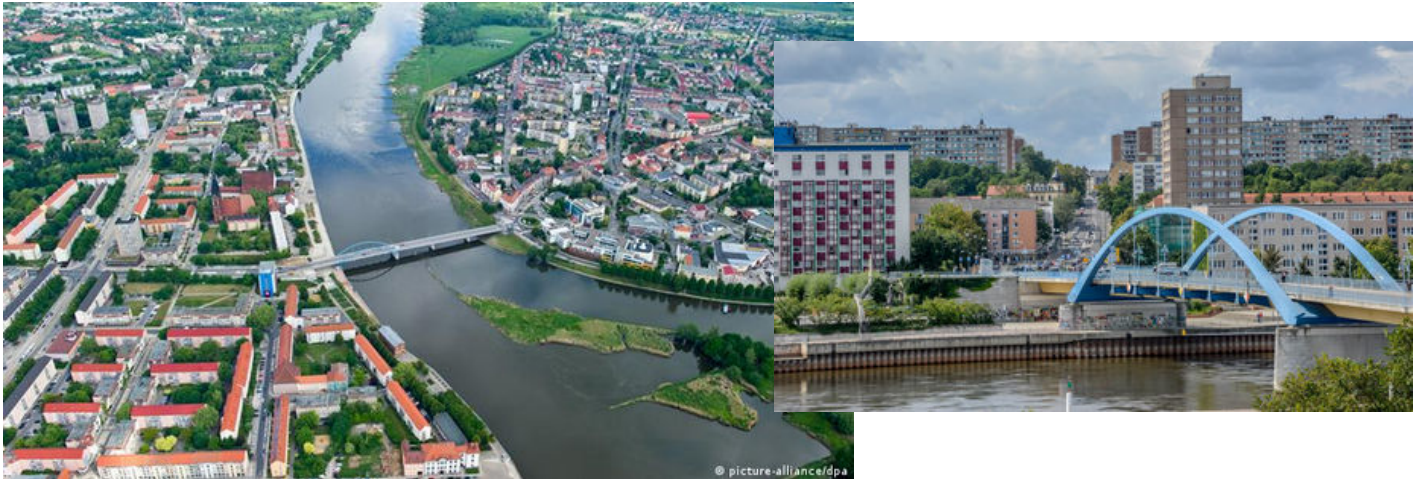

Frankfurt (Oder):

Frankfurt (Oder) is a city with 58,230 inhabitants (31 December 2022) in the state of Brandenburg. The medium-sized city is located on the western bank of the Oder River and is the border town with the Republic of Poland. The neighboring Polish town of Słubice was created in 1945 from the Frankfurt district of Dammvorstadt. Participants will have an opportunity to cross the border and explore both towns. Frankfurt (Oder) is also located 80 km from Berlin.



Kompetenzteam:

Kompetenzteam is a group of young people from Poland and Germany. The residents of Frankfurt (Oder) and Słubice meet at least once a month to discuss various topics together. They are also the group that helps us to organize the Summer Camp. The group was set up in 2010 to bring together people from both towns. It currently has around 30-40 active members.
